Introduction

About this Document

This document is aimed at users who are members of [Maryland's ArcGIS Online organization](#) and want to use the MD iMAP Web App Template inside of ArcGIS Online. This document explains how to configure the template.

What is the MD iMAP Web App Template?

The MD iMAP Web App Template is a JavaScript based application that allows users to have a consistent look and feel for their web mapping applications. The MD iMAP Web App Template provides additional tools and layout options that can be easily configured to enhance the web mapping application experience over typical templates. This template is not a native mobile application but has responsive design to work with browsers on mobile devices.

Sharing Web Maps and Making Web Applications

Sharing the Web Map

Once you have finished setting up your Web Map in ArcGIS Online, click the Share button in the menu bar in the ArcGIS Online Web Map.

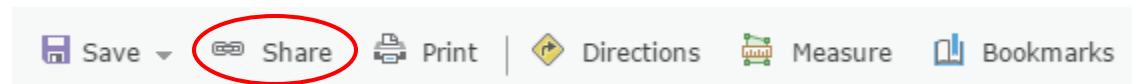


Figure 2: Share Button in ArcGIS Online Menu

In the Share dialog, if you wish to share your MD iMAP Web App Template application with the public, you must share your Web Map with the public, click the “Everyone (public)” checkbox to make the Web Map accessible to on the web. If you wish to share your MD iMAP Web App Template application only with others in the ArcGIS Online for Maryland organization, click the “ArcGIS Online for Maryland” checkbox or “Members of these groups” followed by the specific group.

Note: If you do not share your Web Map publicly, you will be prompted to login in order to view the application

Make a Web Application

Once you have shared your web map, click the “Create a Web App” button. The Create a New Web App dialog will appear with the available web application templates within the ArcGIS Online for Maryland organization under the Configurable Apps tab.

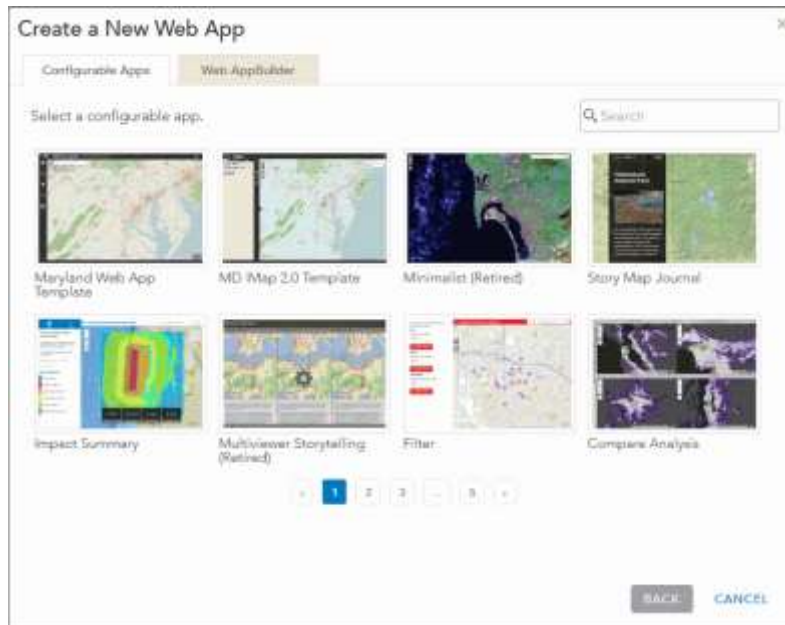


Figure 4: Create a New Web App Dialog in ArcGIS Online

Hover over the Maryland Web App Template and Click “Select”, then when the option shown in the screen below appears click “Create App”.

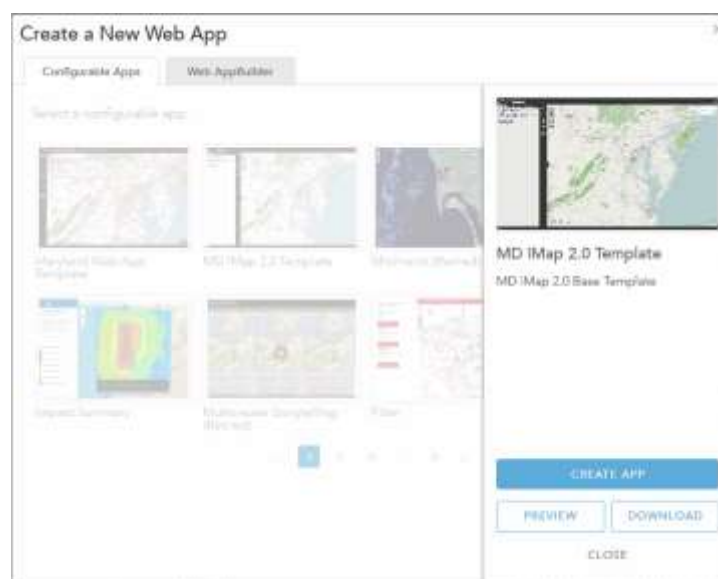
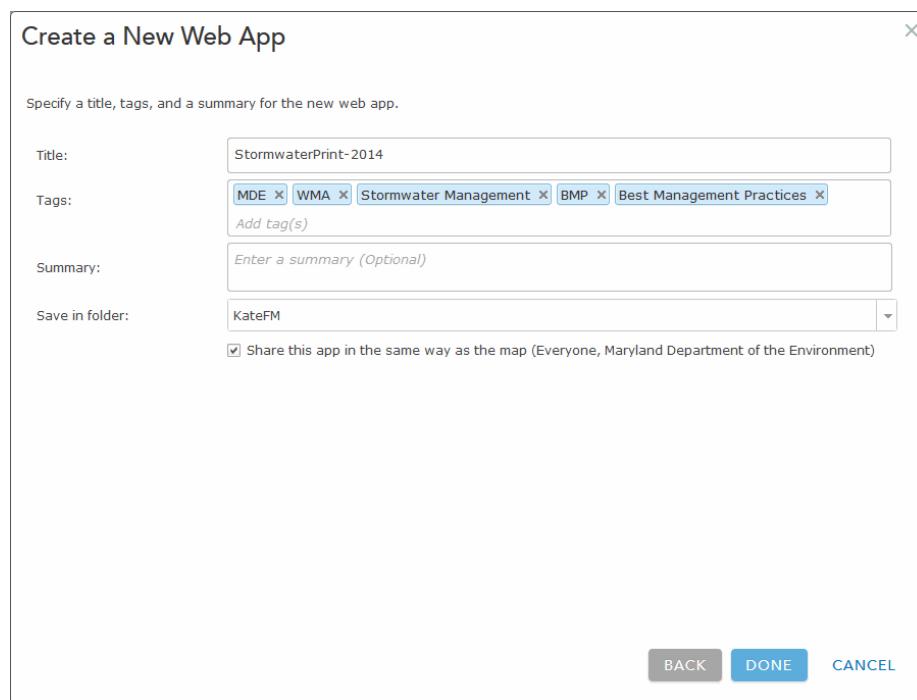


Figure 5: Selecting Web App Template

Provide a title, tags, summary and save location for your application. Then click the “Done” button.

On the left hand side are the groupings of configuration properties. Selecting an item on the left presents a series of changeable parameters.

For widgets and tools, if the item is checked, it means it will be added to the application. If the item is unchecked, it will not be added.

Click the “Save” or “Save and View” button. View will show the resulting application in the right hand side of the browser window. When finished adjusting configurations, click the “Close” button at the bottom right to return to the ArcGIS Online item page.

Updating the Configuration

If you wish to make additional changes to the configuration of your MD iMAP Web App Template application once you have finished the initial configuration, you can go the Details of your Web Application inside of ArcGIS Online and click on the “Configure App” button to open the configuration options window again and make changes.

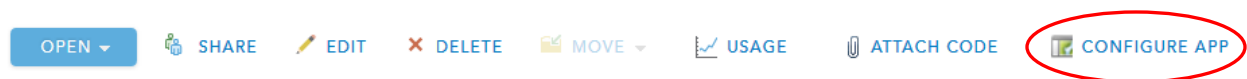


Figure 8: ArcGIS Online Web Application - Configure App
